CPP Reimbursement FAQs

Updated July 1, 2024

How far back can I request reimbursement?

NRPVYC requests that reimbursement requests are submitted within 6 months of the service date.

I'm currently in the CPP training program. Can I request reimbursement for attending training or other continuing education?

No. This reimbursement is intended for activities integral to CPP but not generally reimbursable by Medicaid/insurance.

I live outside of Nebraska. Can I be reimbursed?

No. Due to funding restrictions, reimbursements are only available to Nebraska licensed clinicians who are fully trained in CPP or currently in CPP Training.

Can I combine multiple months of work onto one form/request?

Yes, you can submit up to six months of work in one request – **the dates of services and all details must be listed for each type of work performed**. If you are performing a lot of work over multiple days (that won't fit one page), then it is recommended that you use more than one form.

I performed many hours of work in the same category. Can I still receive the full reimbursement?

Refer to the Reimbursement Eligibility section at <u>nebraskababies.com/ecmh/cop/cpp-</u> <u>reimbursement-program</u>. Most categories of work are limited to 1-3 hours per case or month. Each clinician is limited to requesting a <u>maximum of \$10,000 per year</u> between January 1, 2024, to December 31, 2025, or until available reimbursement funds have been exhausted.
